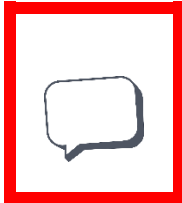

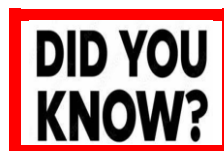
The first year's membership is FREE and our membership fees are of the lowest you will find amongst voluntary organisations.
